Free Nursery Places for Eligible Two Year Olds

If you are on low income, call the Family Information Service on 020 8825 5588 to check to see if you are eligible for 15 hours per week of free childcare for 2 year olds. You will need your NI number or National Asylum Support Service number.

NHS Development Checks

If your child is aged between 8-12 months or 23-30 months, it is time to book a health and development check. It is your chance to find out about your child's development and speech and language.
